






WHAT MAKE SOME DRIVERS MORE RISKY?























Based on physiological information coupled with enforcement of official experience of how drugs can be read;

- Pupil size (3 to 6,5)Pupils reaction to light
- •Nystagmus
- •Inability to see in the cross •Pulse (60-90 beats per minute) •Time and balance control

Evaluated against seven drug groups (central calming, inhaling substances, PCP, cannabis, stimulants, hallucinogens and opioids)


