DRUID FIELD IMPAIRMENT TEST

"SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS OF DRUGS OR OTHER SUBSTANCES"

• Drug Evaluation Expert (DRE)





“SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS COURSE”

Based on physiological information coupled with enforcement of official experience of how drugs can be read;

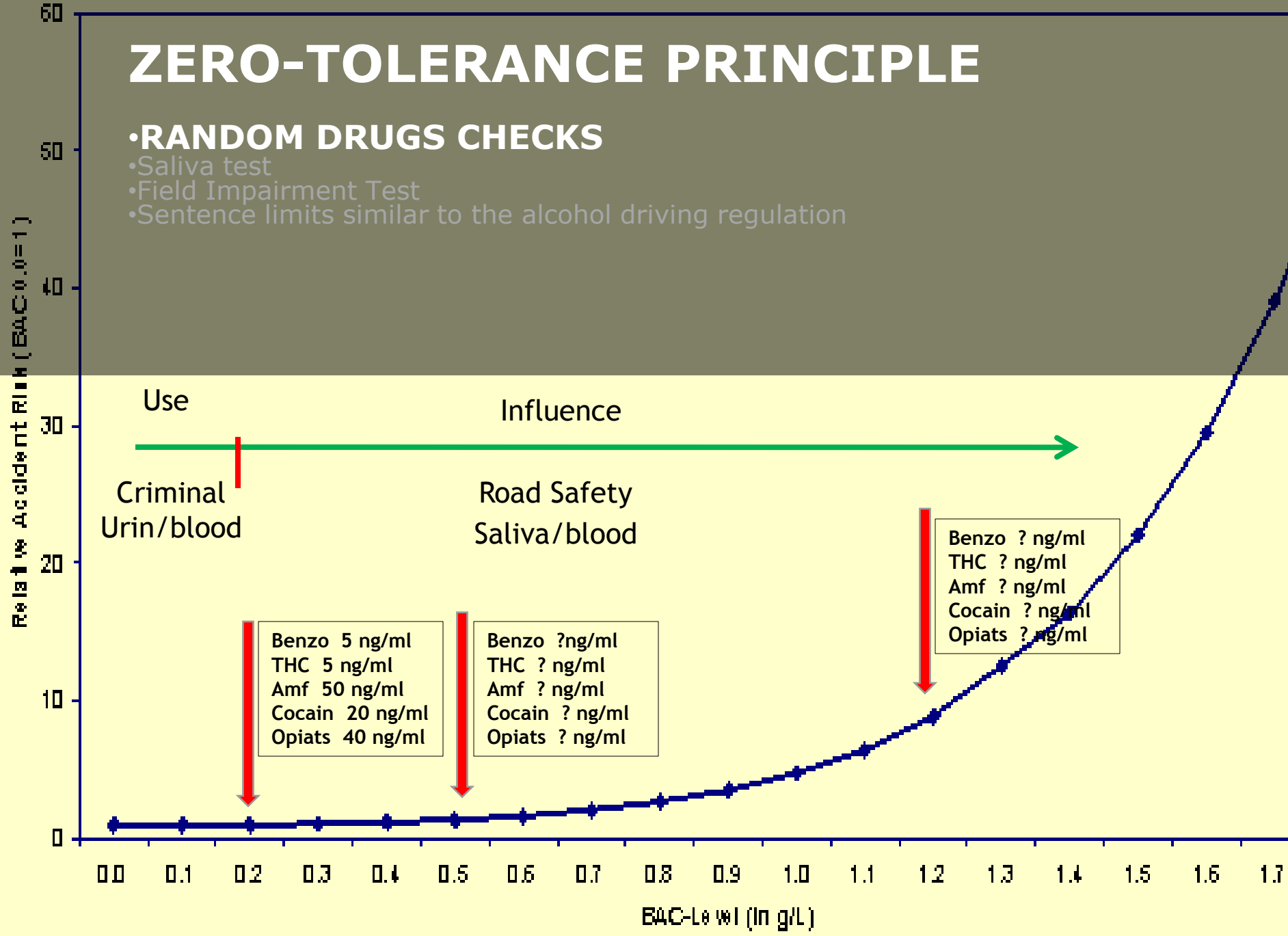
- Pupil size (3 to 6,5)
- Pupils reaction to light
- Nystagmus
- Inability to see in the cross
- Pulse (60-90 beats per minute)
- Time and balance control

Evaluated against seven drug groups (central calming, inhaling substances, PCP, cannabis, stimulants, hallucinogens and opioids)

ZERO-TOLERANCE PRINCIPLE

•RANDOM DRUGS CHECKS

- Saliva test
- Field Impairment Test
- Sentence limits similar to the alcohol driving regulation
