In 2009 ETSC launched a new project Preventing Road Accidents and Injuries for the Safety of Employees (PRAISE) to increase road safety in the work context. The project was co-funded by the European Commission, Fundación MAPFRE, the German Road Safety Council (DVR) and the Swiss Council for Accident Prevention (bfu). It aimed to "praise" best practices in order to help employers secure high road safety standards for their employees.
