




## **ETSC PIN Programme**

## **Road Safety PIN Awards 2011**



- ✓ Substantial and sustainable reduction in road deaths since 2001
- ✓ Implementation of comprehensive road safety policies and measures
- ✓ Increased enforcement of major traffic offences



## **Road Safety PIN Award 2011**



- ✓ Achieved a 58% reduction in road deaths between 2001 and 2010
- ✓ Has reached the EU target
- ✓ Cut road deaths per million population by more than half between 2001 and 2010




- Achieved a 50% reduction in road deaths between 2001 and 2010
- Cut road deaths per million inhabitants by half between 2001 and 2010
- ✓ Is the country with the lowest road mortality in the EU: 28 deaths per million




## Progress towards the EU target
