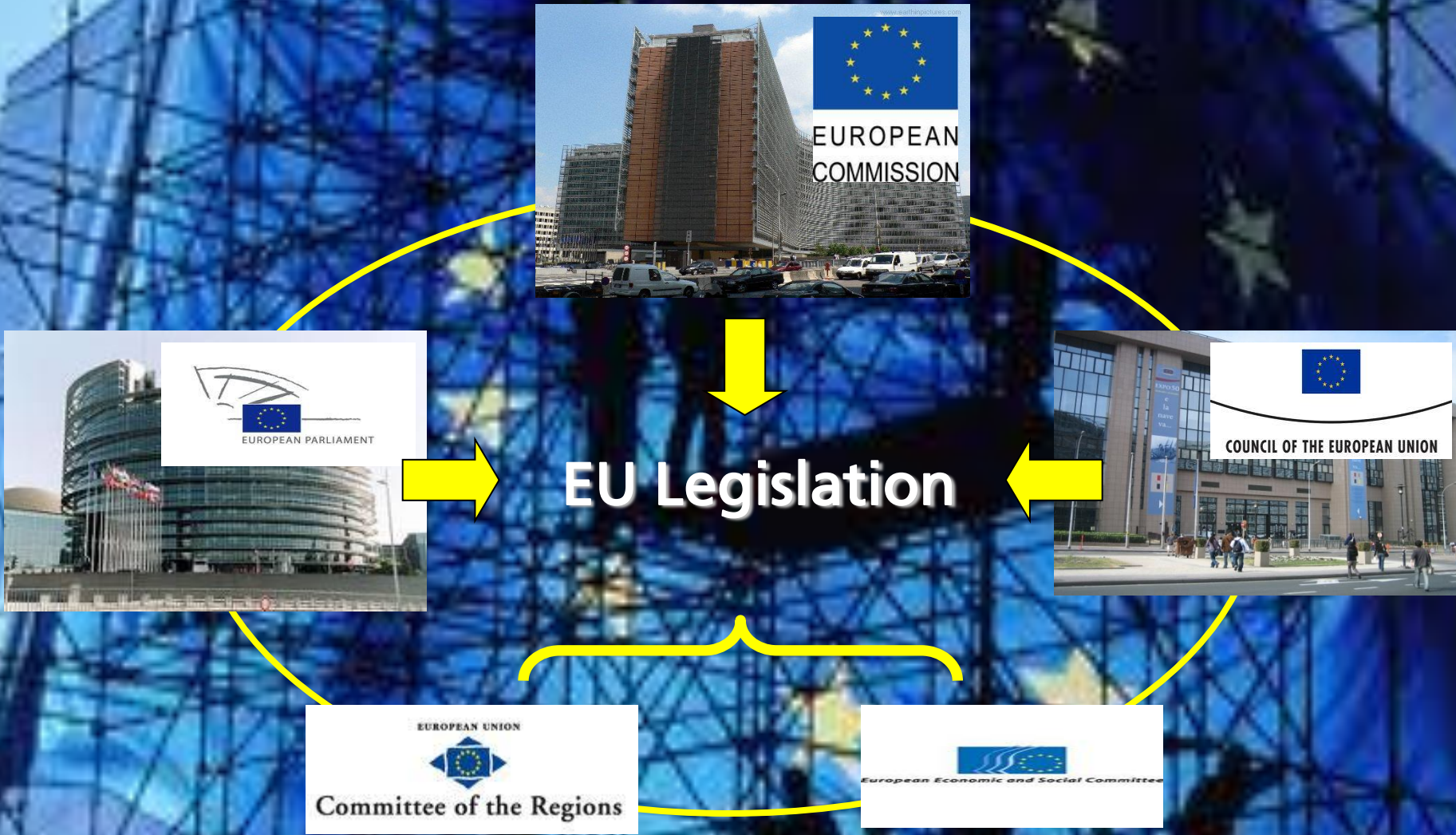

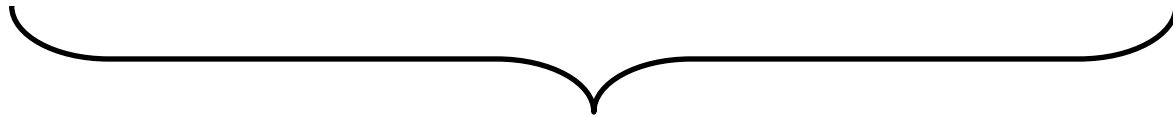
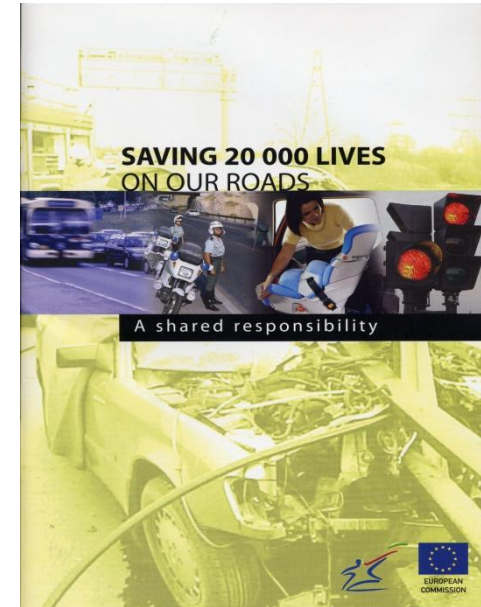
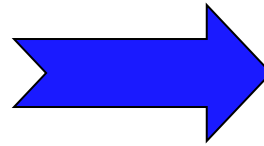


Road (un-)safety in Europe

- ➡ Around **35,000** deaths in the EU in 2009
- ➡ Around **1.7 million** injured people recorded by police, among them:
300,000 seriously injured
- ➡ EU Socio-economic cost: **€ 200 billion**
