
Renewed ambition at EU level

- EU target of halving road deaths between 2010 and 2020 => no more than 15,500 deaths in 2020;
- 43% reduction in road deaths between 2001 and 2010;
- High pace of reductions towards the end of the decade: -11% in 2010, -11% in 2009, -8% in 2008;
- Eight countries achieved reductions of 50% or more between 2001 and 2010: Latvia, Estonia, Lithuania, Spain, Luxembourg, France, Slovenia and Sweden;
- 2010 was an exceptionally good year in reducing road deaths



Mixed progress in 2011

Percentage change in road deaths between 2010 and 2011






Implications

- 944 fewer road deaths in 2011 than in 2010 for the EU as a whole
- To reach the EU road safety target through equal annual steps a drop of 6.7% per year would have been needed in 2011, amounting to 1,136 additional road deaths that could have been prevented
- Using the Value of Preventing one Fatality (VPF) as updated to reflect 2011 economic situation of 1.84 million EUR:
 - Societal benefits to the order of 1.74 billion EUR were achieved in 2011 for the EU as a whole
 - Additional societal benefits of 2.09 billion EUR could have been achieved





Road Safety Performance (1)


Number of road deaths per million inhabitants

Serious injuries


- More than 324,000 recorded as seriously injured in traffic collisions in 2011;
- No common definition at EU level;
- High level of under-reporting and mis-reporting of serious injuries in traffic
