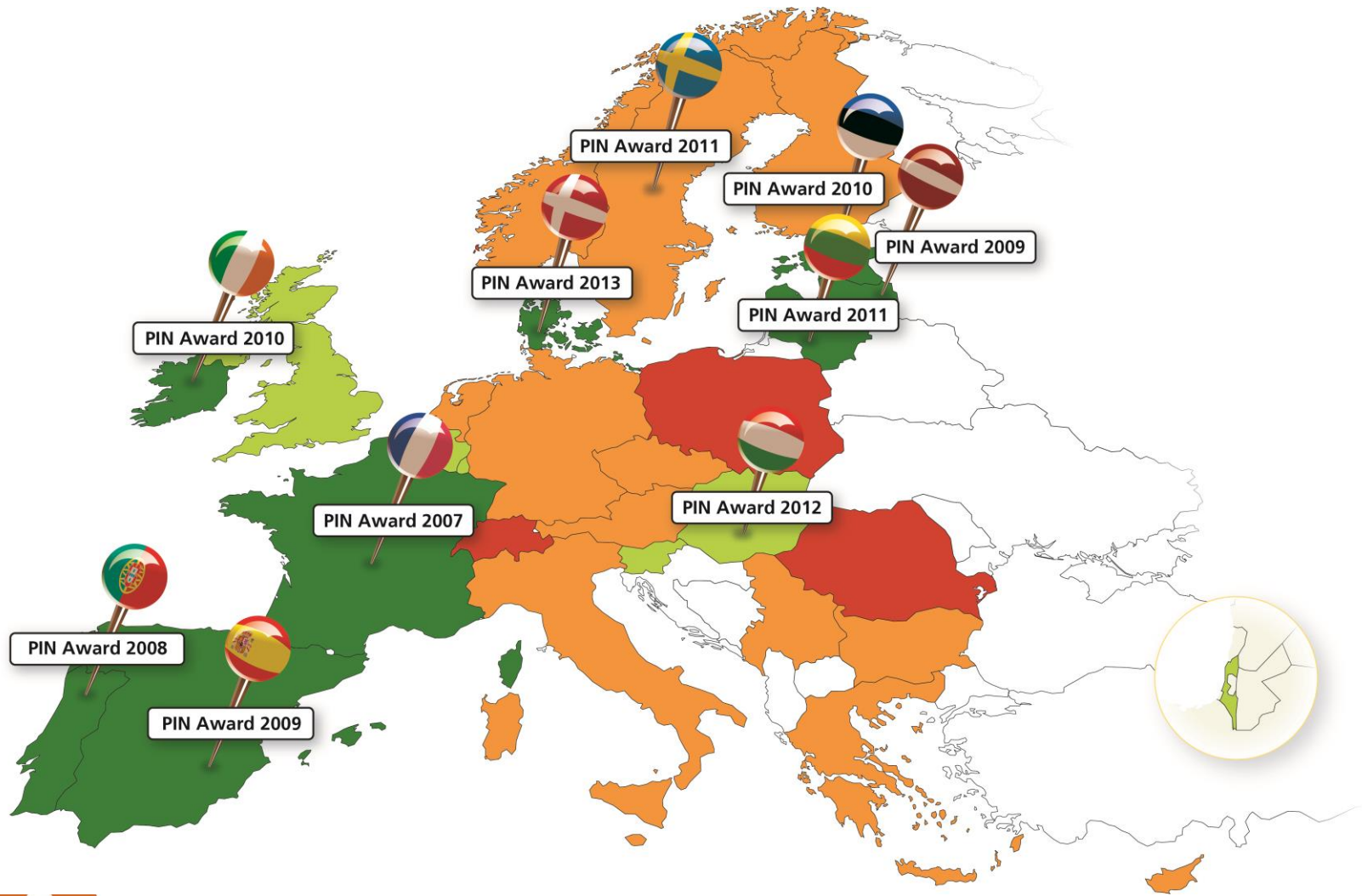

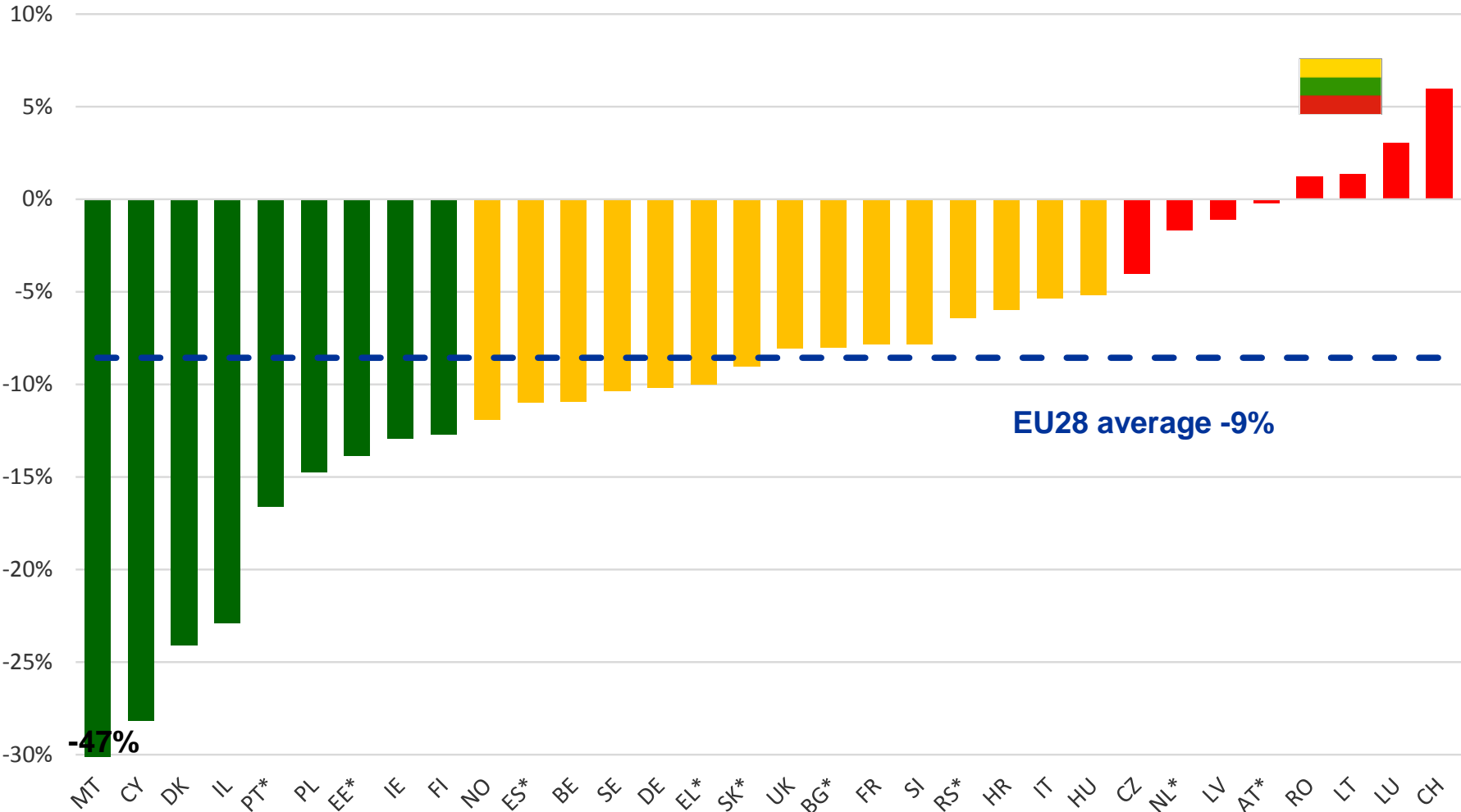
ETSC PIN Programme

- Launched in June 2006 to **compare country performance** in road safety
- Currently includes the **28 EU Member States**, as well as Israel, Norway, Serbia and Switzerland
- A **PIN Panel**: experts from each of the 32 countries
- A **PIN Steering Group** with members from
 - SWOV, VTI, UCL and DaCoTA
 - European Commission
 - PIN partners
- **PIN receives support** from **Volvo Trucks, Volvo Group, Swedish Transport Administration, Norwegian Public Roads Administration, Toyota Motor Europe**

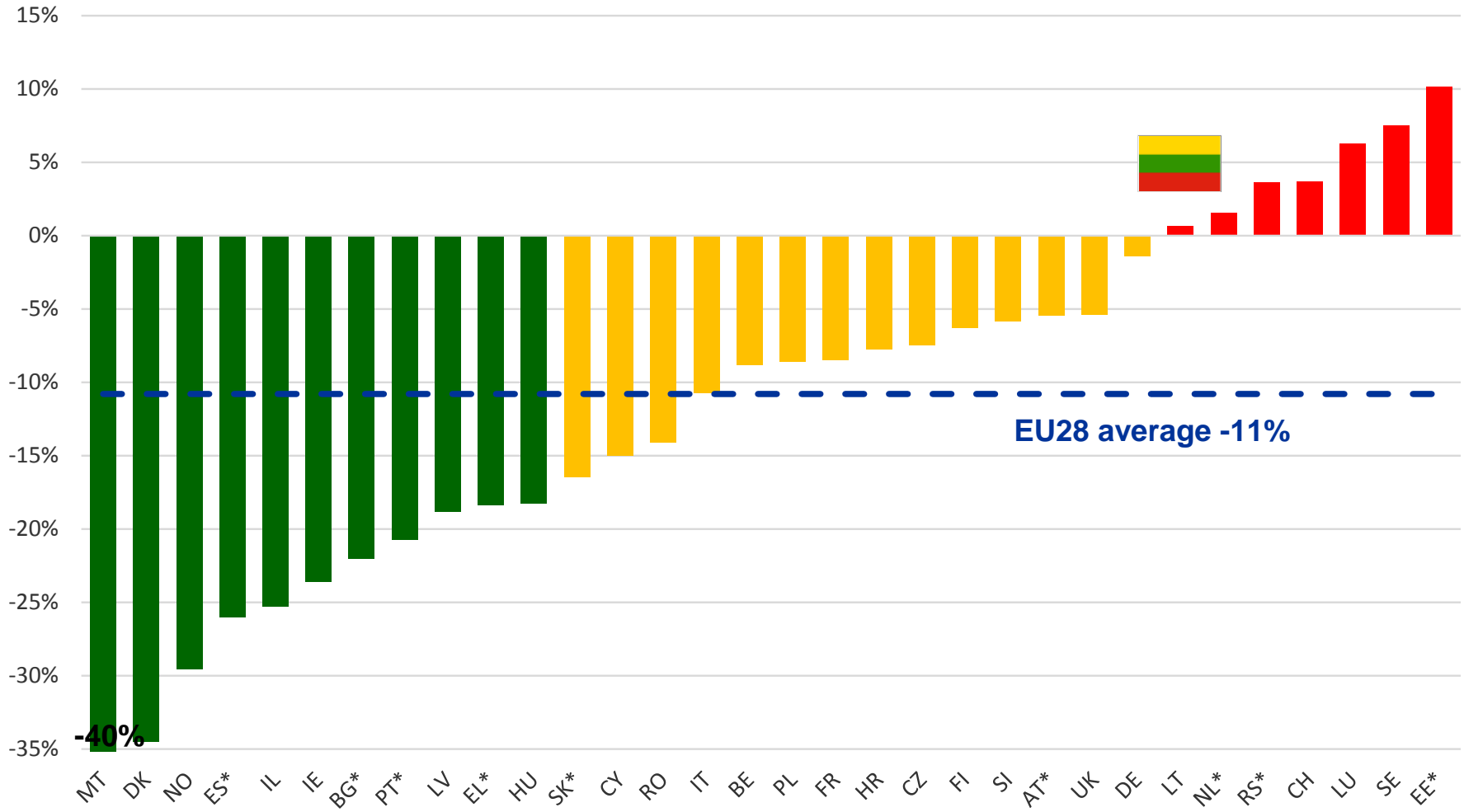
Road Safety PIN Awards



Percentage reduction in deaths 2011-2012

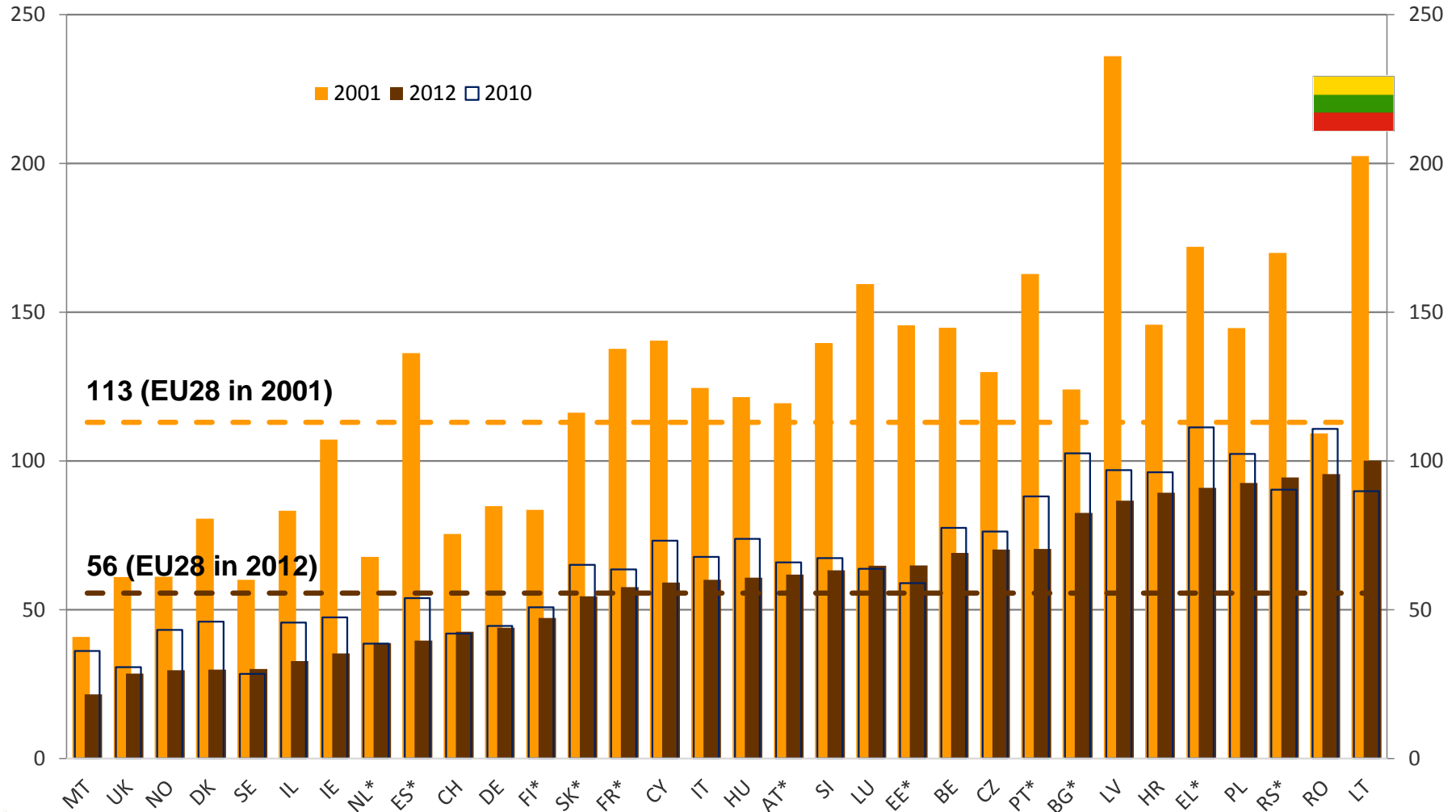


Percentage reduction in deaths 2010-2012



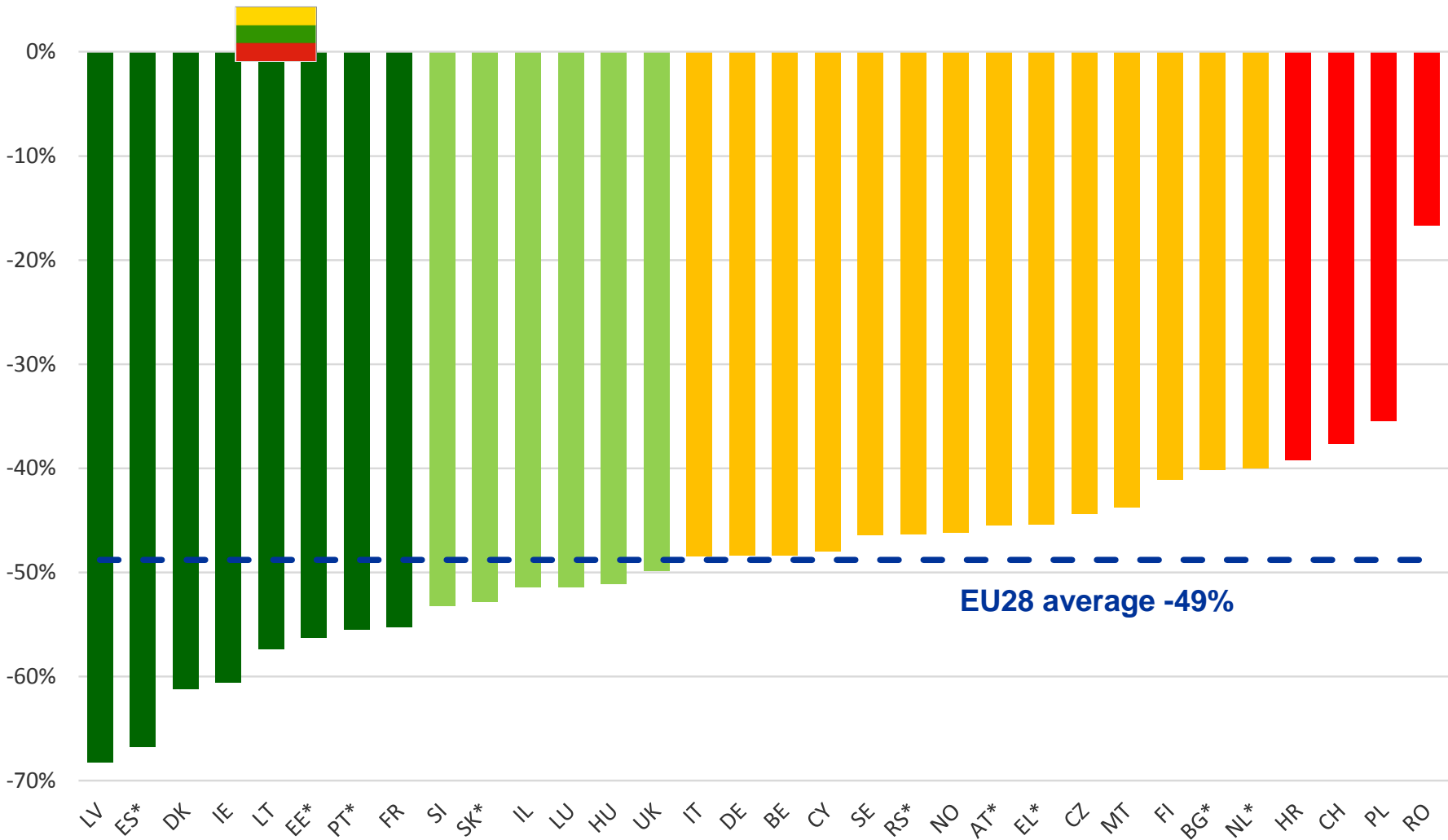
EU28 average -11%

Road mortality in 2012 and 2001

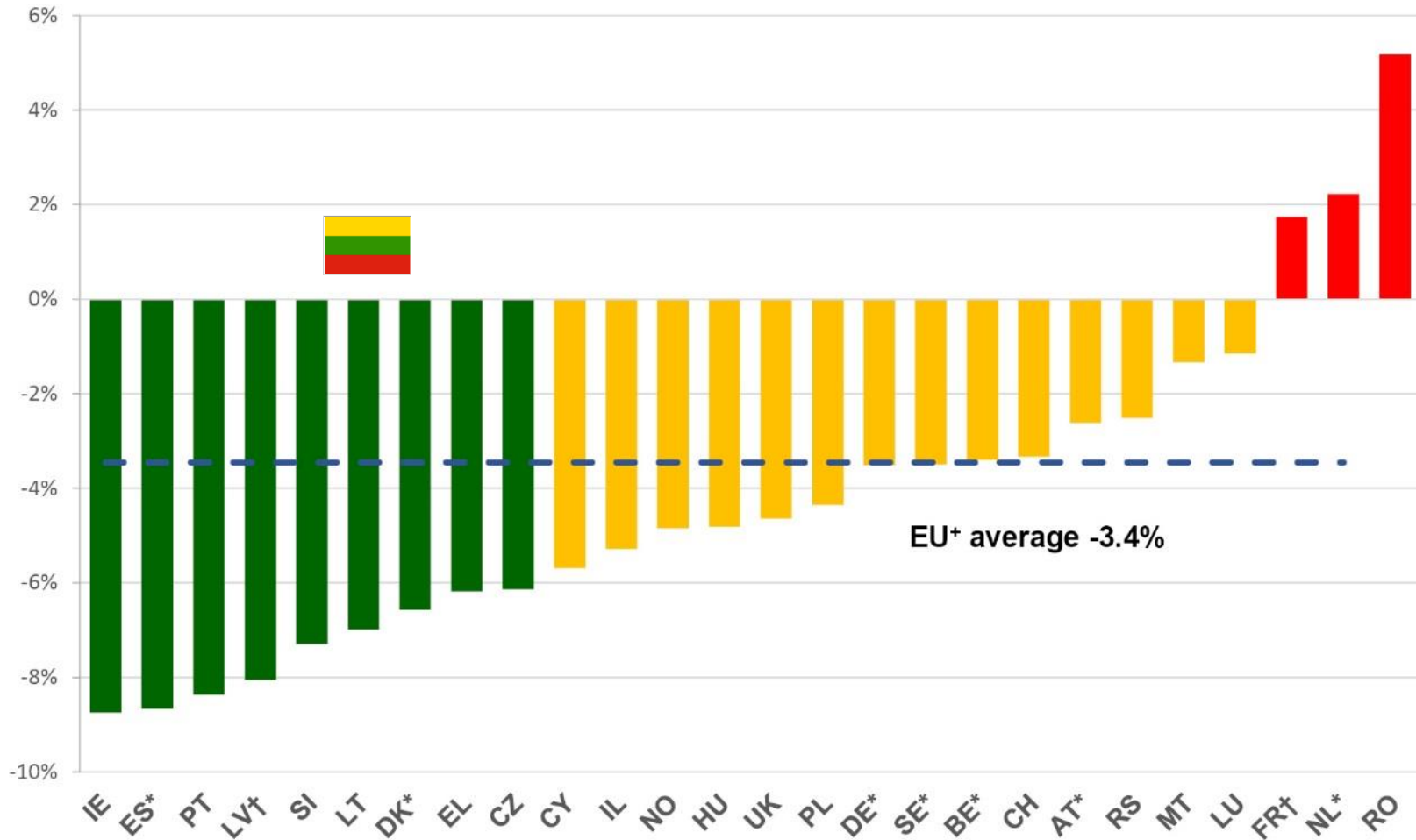


Road deaths per million inhabitants in 2012

Percentage reduction in deaths 2001-2012

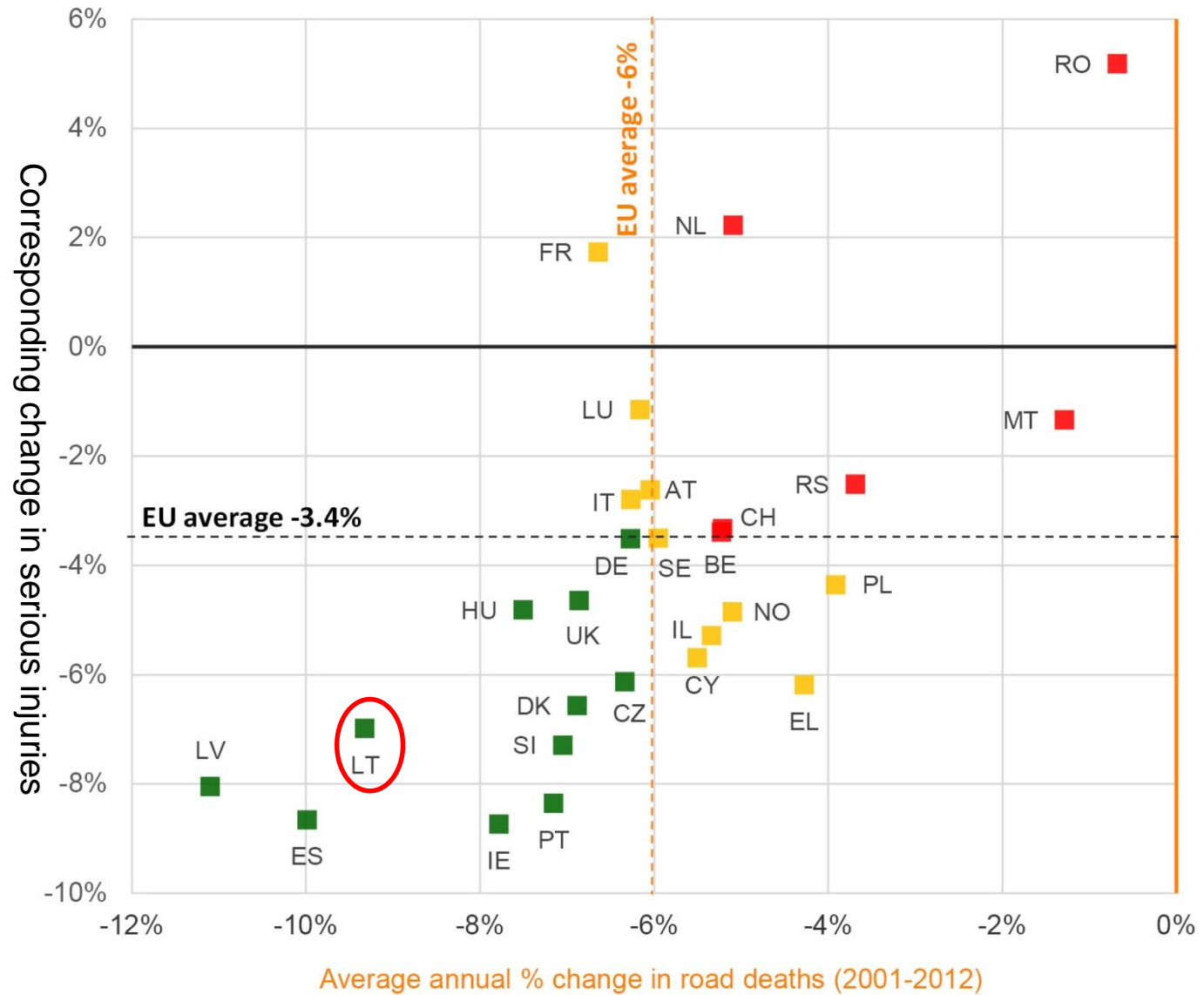


Progress in reducing serious injuries

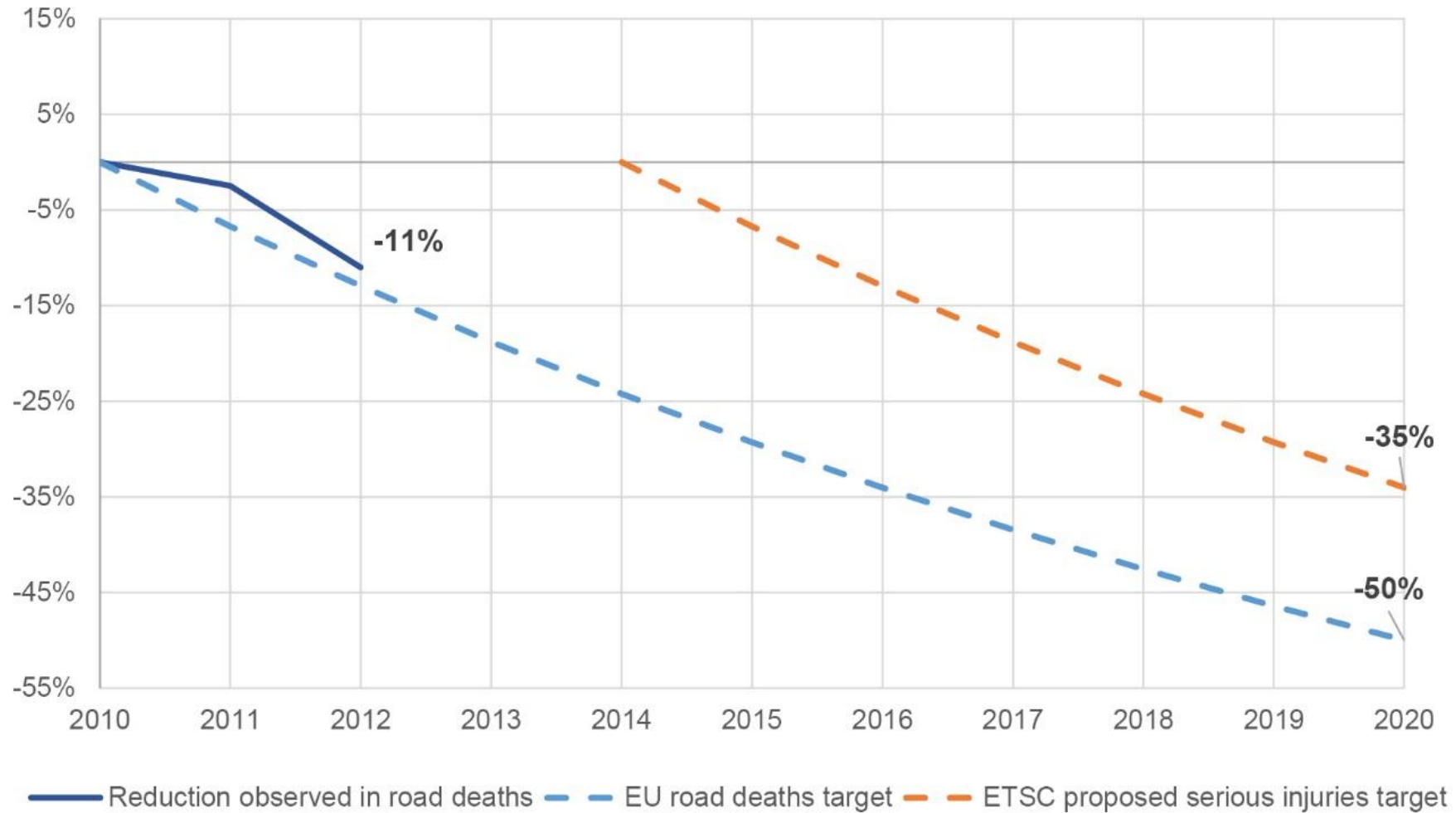


Average annual percentage change in reducing the number of serious injuries
