

ETSC PIN Programme


- Launched in June 2006 to compare country performance in road safety
- Currently includes the 28 EU Member States, as well as Israel, Norway, Serbia and Switzerland
- A PIN Panel: experts from each of the 32 countries
- A PIN Steering Group with members from
 - SWOV, VTI, UCL and DaCoTA
 - European Commission
 - PIN partners
- PIN receives support from Volvo Trucks, Volvo Group, Swedish Transport Administration, Norwegian Public Roads Administration, Toyota Motor Europe


1993 - 2013



Percentage reduction in deaths 2011-2012




Percentage reduction in deaths 2010-2012






Road mortality in 2012 and 2001






Road deaths per million inhabitants in 2012 (and in 2001 and 2010 for comparison)

Percentage reduction in deaths 2001-2012






Progress in reducing serious injuries






Average annual percentage change in reducing the number of serious injuries
