1. GENERAL DATA

Spain

- >500 000 km².
- > 44 million inhabitants.

Amount of vehicules

- > 31 million.
- ➤ 6 M. increase from 2003 to 2008.
- ➤ Increase of 1M per year (4% a year).

Driver census:

- > 25 million
- > 2,8 million increase from 2003 to 2008.
- ➤ Increase of 500,000 per year (2,5%)

Journeys

➤ Increase in road until 2007 by 2% per year. 4.75% decrease in 2008.

Attention to bikes

- > 2.450.000
- > An 900.000 increase in the past 5 years
- > A 180.000 increase per year

2004	Creation of a Road Safety Comission in the National Assembley
2004	Creation of the National Road Safety Obervatory
2005	Boost of the higher Road Safety Council
2005	Drafting of the Road Safety Strategic Plan for 2004-2008
2006	Approval of the penalty point system Law
2007	Increase in traffic police officers with 2000 new incorporations
2007	Creation of the Special PRosecutor's Office for Crimes Against Road Safety
2007	Approval of the Penal Code Modification



4. AWARENESS ON THE AMOUNT OF VICTIMS



- Opening the debate across the media.
- Variable information panels.
- 12M euros every year for awareness campaigns.



5. VICTIM ASSOCIATIONS



- The promotion of victim associations.
- Encouragement and participation of the victim associations.
- Road violence forum (annual).
- World Day of Remembrance for Road Traffic Victims.
- Monument in memory of innocent victims in traffic accidents: "Against indifferencie and oblivion".
- Subsidies to the projects by associations.




6. ALCOHOL AND DRIVING

- Preventive controls on 20% of the driver census.
 - More controls: 2 million in 2003 to 4.5 million in 2007.
 - Positive results: reduced from 4.3% to 1.9%
- It is a crime from 0.6 onwards.
- The promotion of an Alternative Driver.
- The promotion of alcohol-free beer.
- Drivers dead with over 0.3 g/l blood alcohol content.
- Year 2003 34.7%
- Year 2008 28.8%



7. SAFETY BELTS AND HELMETS

- This means the difference between killing yourself or not.
- Special control and surveillance operations.
 - 2 per year, with a duration of 15 days.
 - All the police forces and an Awareness Campaign.
- Promotion of the purchase of vehicles with acoustic and light warning.
- Level of use:



Drivers and passangers dead not wearing seat belt

2003: 34%

2008: 22%

The use of the **seat belt has increased by 10 points**, both on roads and in urban areas, after the introduction of the Driving Licence with Points.



8. DISTRACTIONS

40% of deadly accidents are due to driving outside the road.

An inadequate speed leads to greater distractions.

Examples:

- Mobile phones
- Navigators
- Smoking while driving
- Headphones
- Drowsiness



9. SPEED

The Plan for the installation of fixed radars.

2008	800 radars (500 fixed + 300 mobile)
2008	National Automatic Reporting Treatment Centre.



Objectives: - 2000 radars in year 2012.

- control of average speeds in 2009.

The promotion of speed limiters.


Results: The decrease in average speeds is at around 3 to 4 km/h according to the type of road

Vehicles detected by radar over 140 Km/h: 2005: 6,8% 2008: 0,8%


THE DRIVING LICENCE WITH POINT Start-up on 1st July 2006.






11.TREND IN THE NUMBER OF VICTIMS

PEOPLE KILLED IN ROAD ACCIDENTS 1996 - 2008





WORK THEMES 1

The promotion of the preparation of Municipal Road Safety Plans

2007 Publication of the standard urban road safety plan.

2008 Preparation of plans in five representative cities.

2012 Compulsory for cities over 50,000 inhabitants.

Taking road safety to companies

Inclusion of road safety education in the permanent training plans for workers.

2009 Inclusion of road safety in collective negotiation.

2010 Promotion of company road safety plans.



WORK THEMES 2

The improvement of safety on bike trips.

2007

Preparation of the Bike Safety Plan.

2008

- Improvement of access to motorbikes.
- Examination for obtaining the moped licence.
- Raising the age for mopeds up to 15 years old.
- Inclusion of driving tests.
- Awareness campaigns.

2009

- Inclusion of the European Directive on Driving Licences.
 New A-2 Licence.
- The promotion of ABS on bikes.
- 2,000 km of safe guard railings.



WORK THEMES 3

2009 New law on fining procedure

Objective: To avoid impunity and reduce the handling time

- Includes the electronic address, this being forceful for companies and recommended for private individuals.
- Update of the offences and fines.
- Update of the licence with points.
- Better adaptation to the automatic offence detection systems.
