





### Near miss reporting

Explain your aims. Seek the opinion of the workforce.

### **Risk assessments**

- Analyse tacho records.
- · Check for tipping on break.
- Produce black spot maps.
- Provide list of safe havens.
- · Check speed compliance.

✓ Lesson learned

Enlist Champions. Win over the difficult employees first.

#### **Risk assessments**

- Externally train the trainers.
- Fit on-board computers to identify skill shortages.
- Replace periodic training with intervention training.
- Base training on a robust safety culture

### ✓ Lesson learned


Produce a plan. System must be consistent across the business.






