


Fatalities - evolution 2001-2012




Preliminary 2012

- Increasing traffic volumes
- High risks of low roadworthiness (old vehicle fleet)
- Speeding
- Seat belt use
- Mixed traffic (no separate lanes for vulnerable road users)

- Urban area road safety
