In 2009 ETSC launched a project "Preventing Road Accidents and Injuries for the Safety of Employees" (PRAISE) to increase road safety in the work context. The project was co-funded by the European Commission, the Fundación MAPFRE, the German Road Safety Council (DVR) and the Swiss Council for Accident Prevention (bfu). It aimed to "praise" best practices in order to help employers secure high road safety standards for their employees. In the framework of this campaign, ETSC organised a series of seminars in selected Member States bringing together companies, fleet safety managers, government, and road safety experts.

Building on the successful Spanish PRAISE seminars held in Barcelona, Oviedo, Madrid and recently in Malaga, ETSC is organising the first PRAISE seminar in Portugal to promote the research that has been done within PRAISE over the last three years, but also put forward some of the recommendations and best practices in companies in specific work related areas. In co-operation with the Fundación MAPFRE, the PRAISE seminar will be held on Thursday 18th October in Lisbon.
