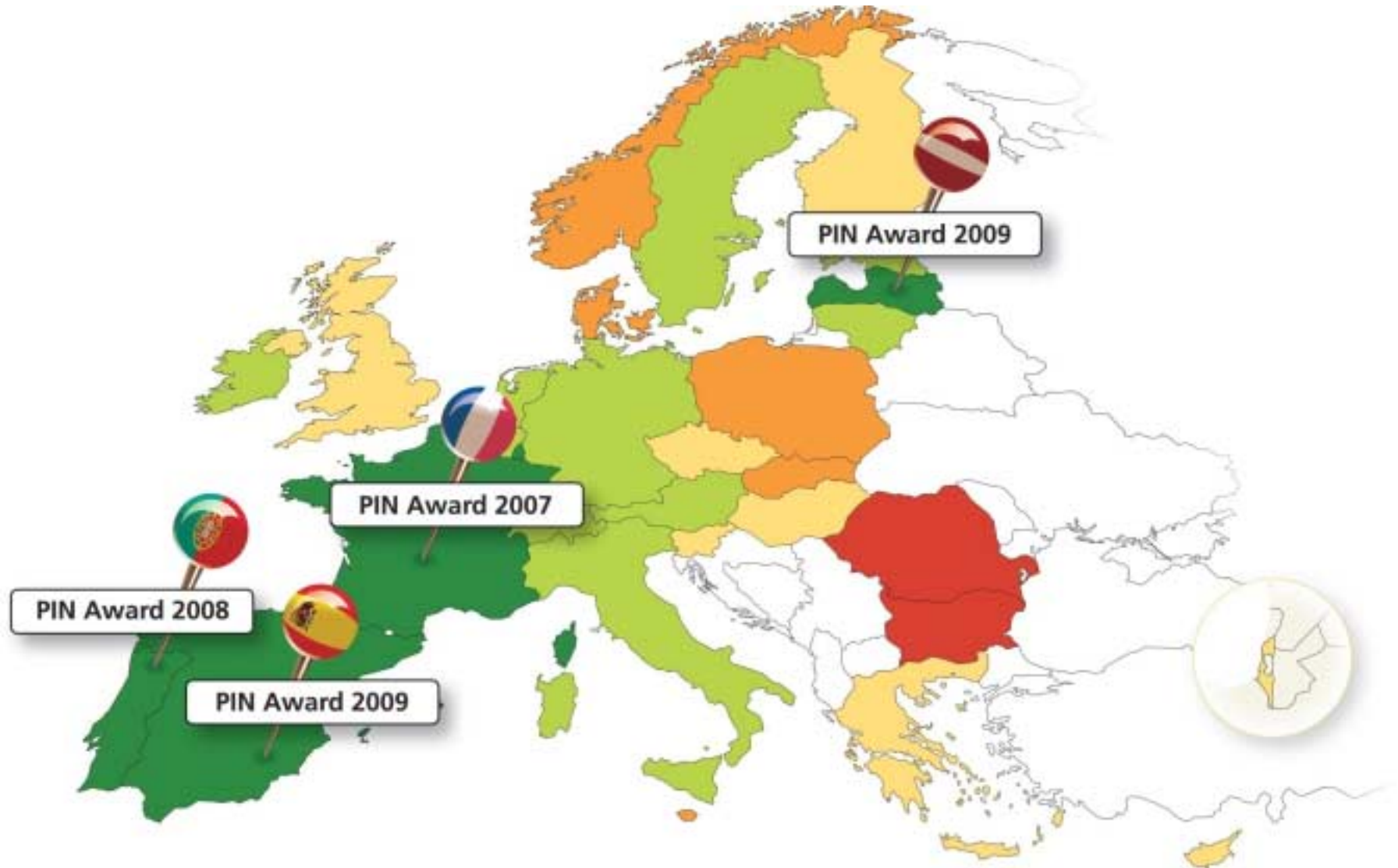

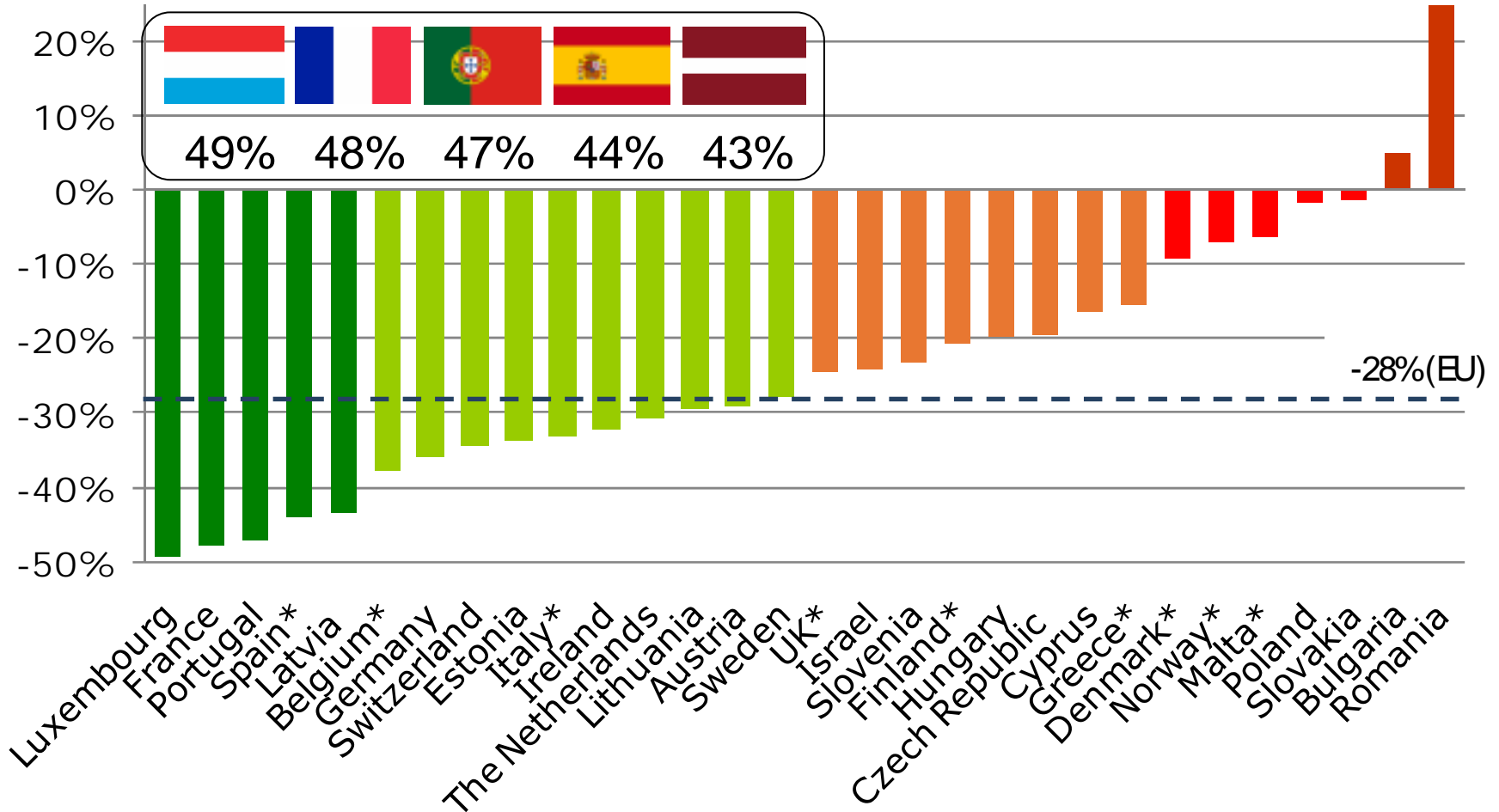
Road Safety PIN Award 2009



- ✓ Substantial and sustainable reduction in road deaths since 2001
- ✓ Reductions despite traffic volume increases
- ✓ Implementation of comprehensive road safety policies and measures
- ✓ Better enforcement of major traffic offences

Percentage change in road deaths between 2001 and 2008



No complacency

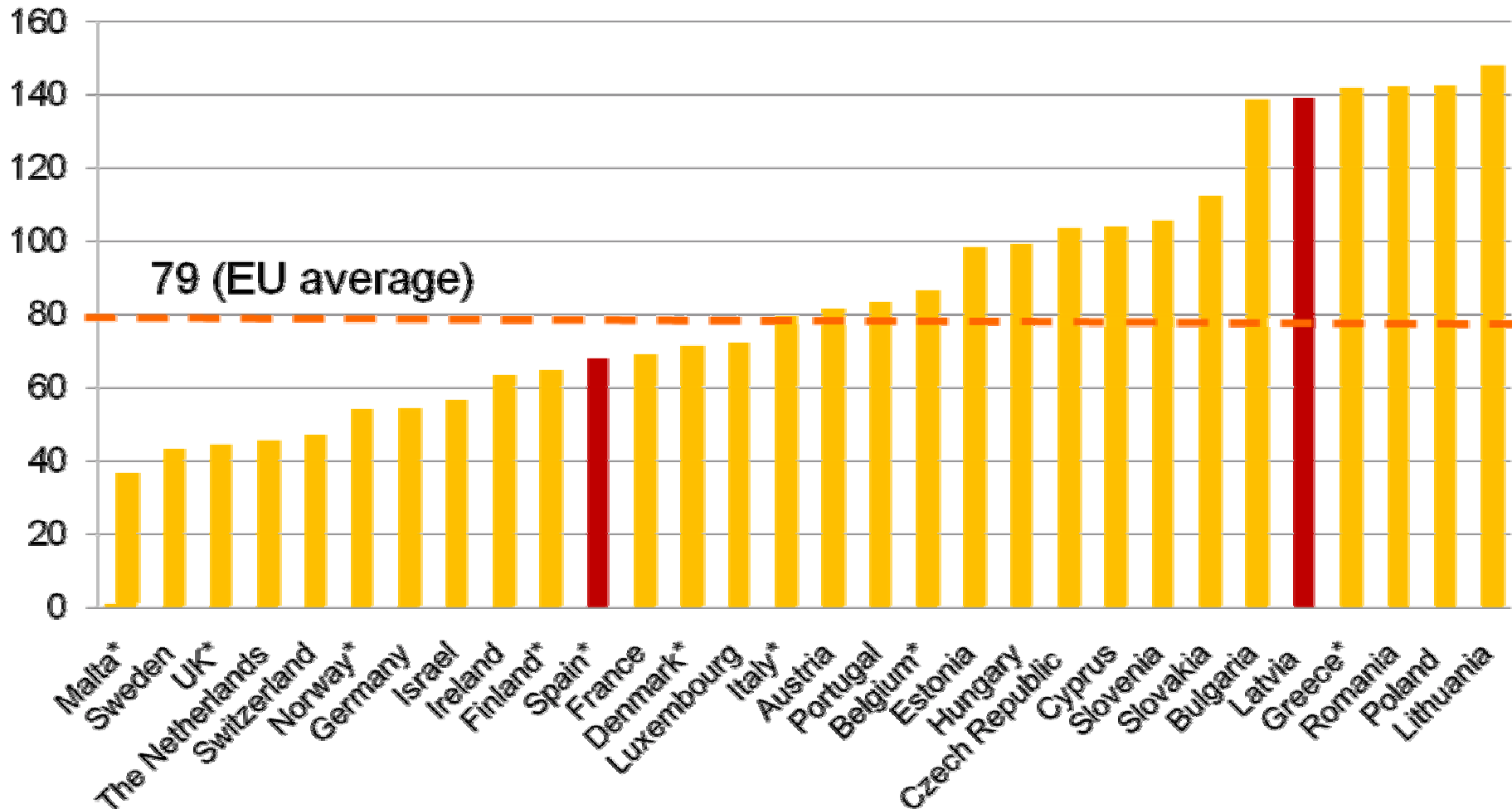


- Still more than **3,000** people die on Spanish roads each year
- 68 road deaths per million population
- 8th out of 27 in road mortality



- More than **300** people lost their life on Latvian roads in 2008
- 139 road deaths per million population
- 5th worst in road mortality (23rd out of 27)

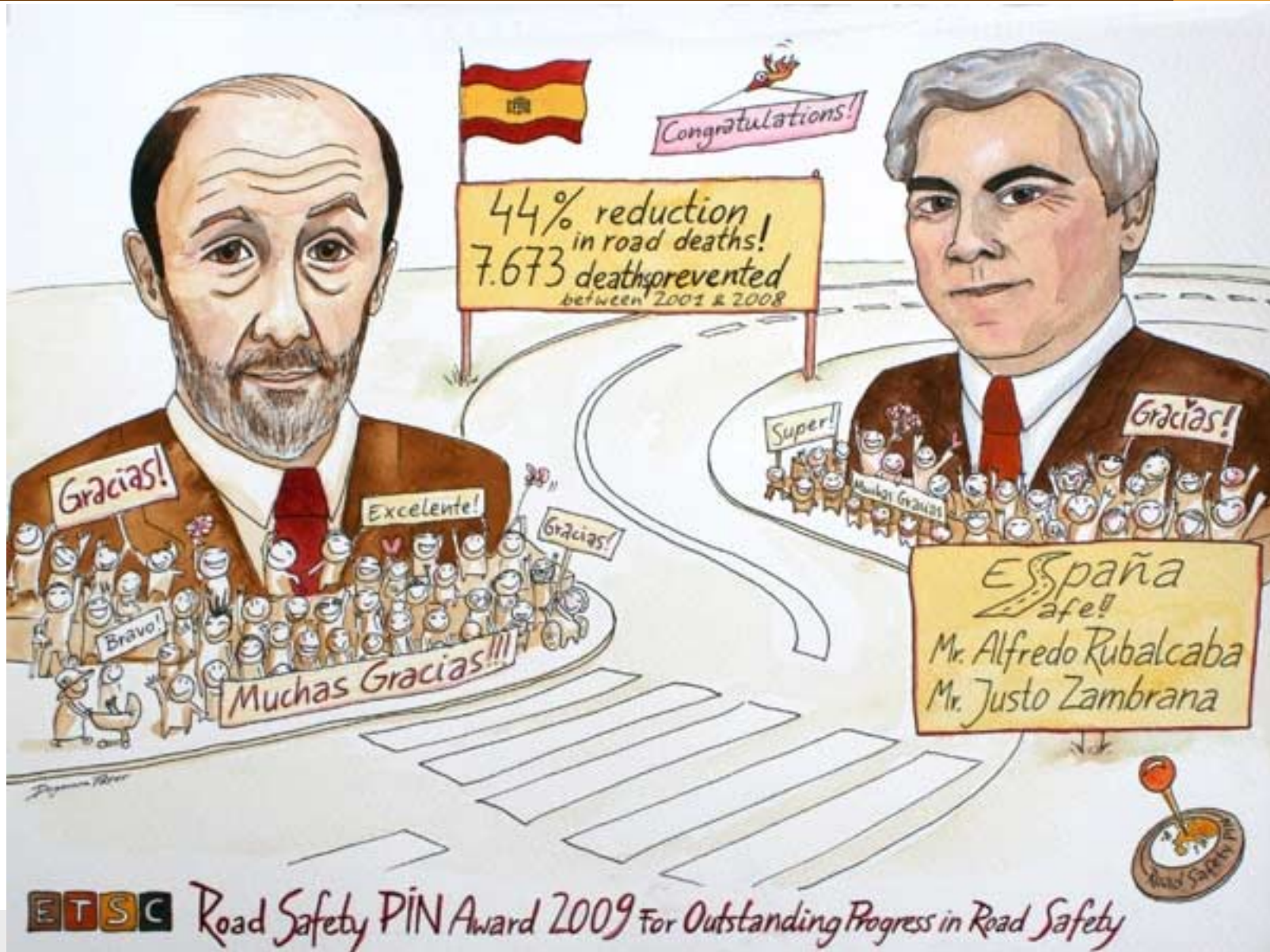

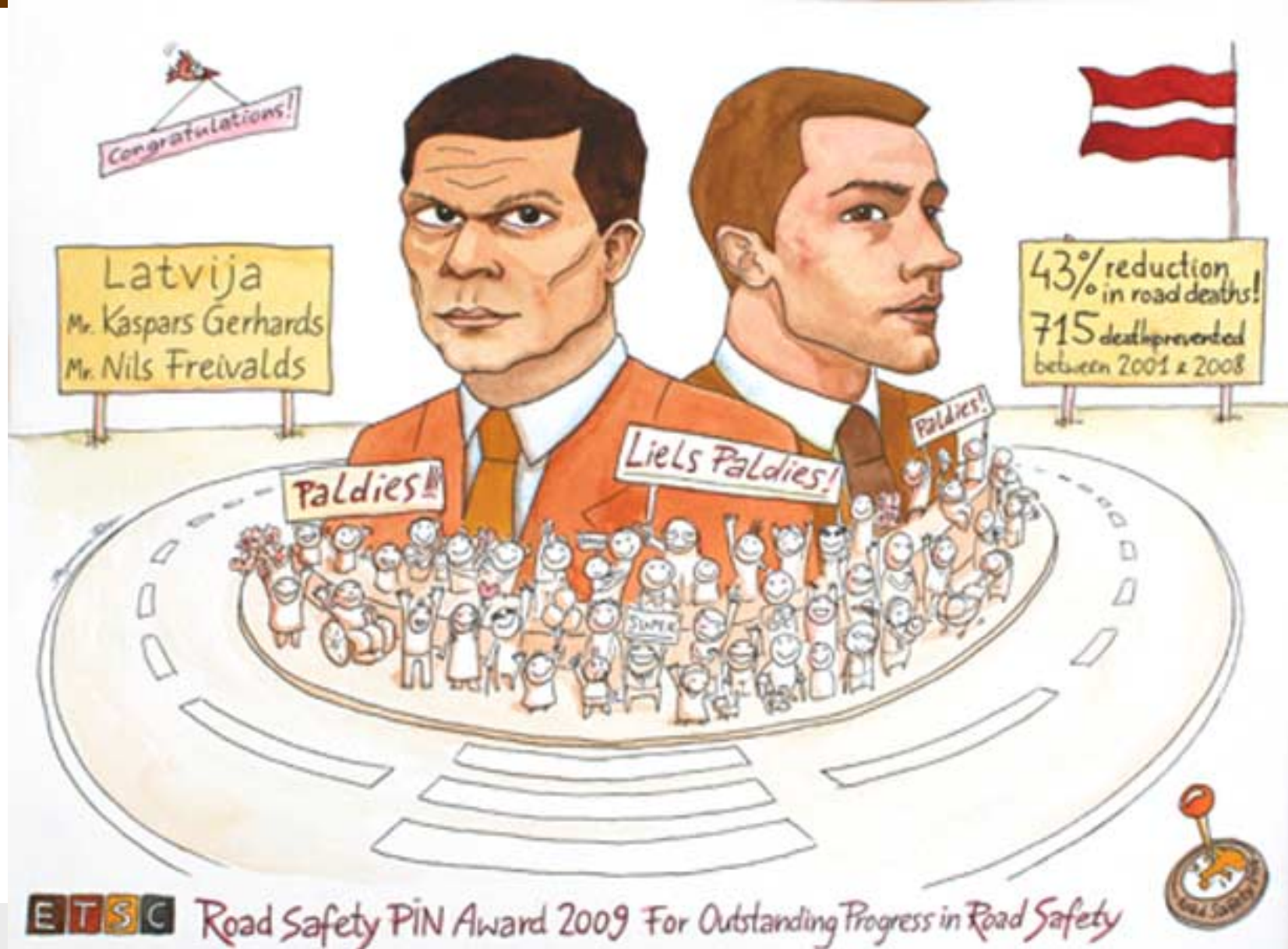
